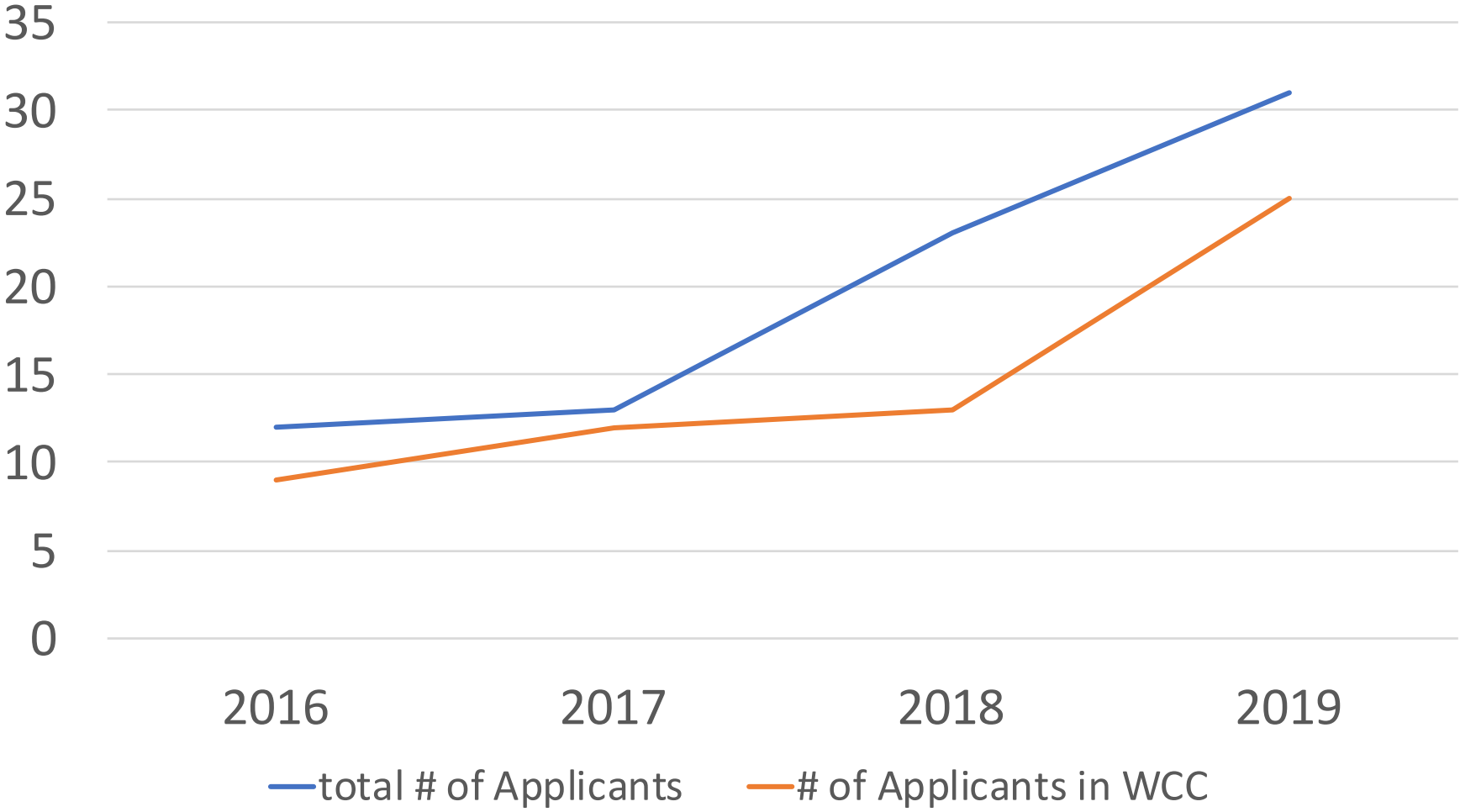

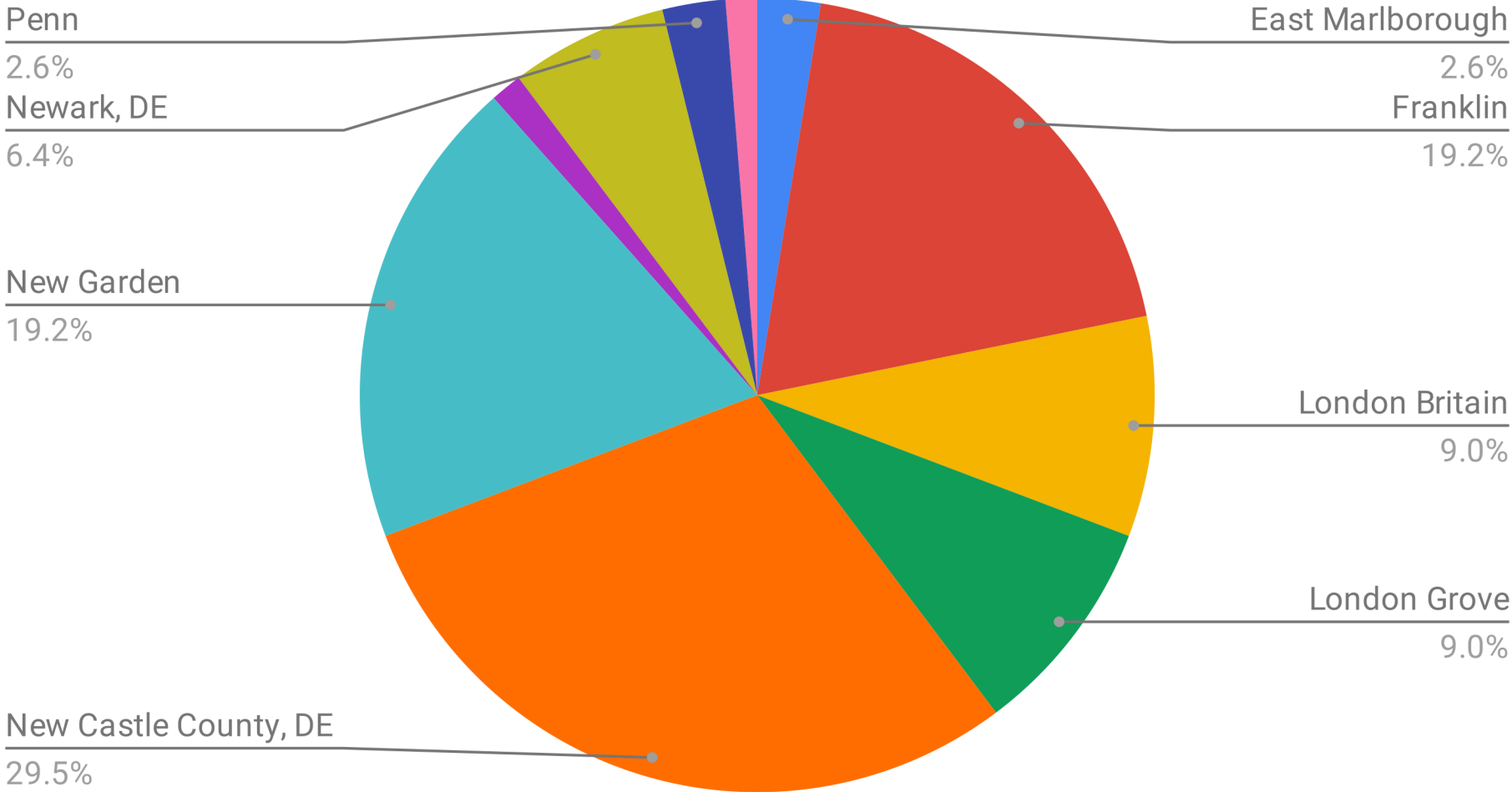
Program Stats 2016-2019

CTR Applicants 2016-2019

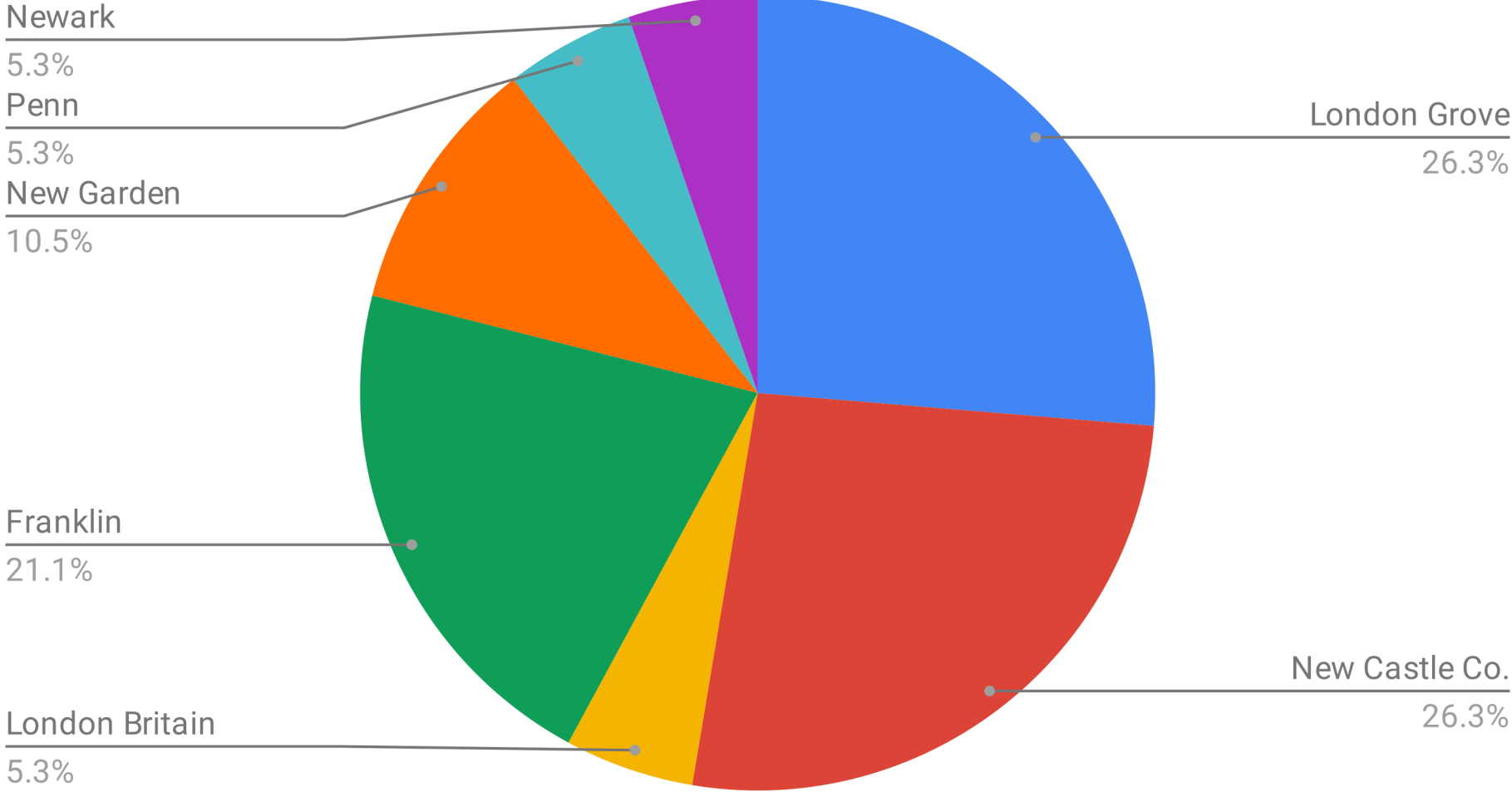


80 Total Applicants to date, 25% outside of White Clay

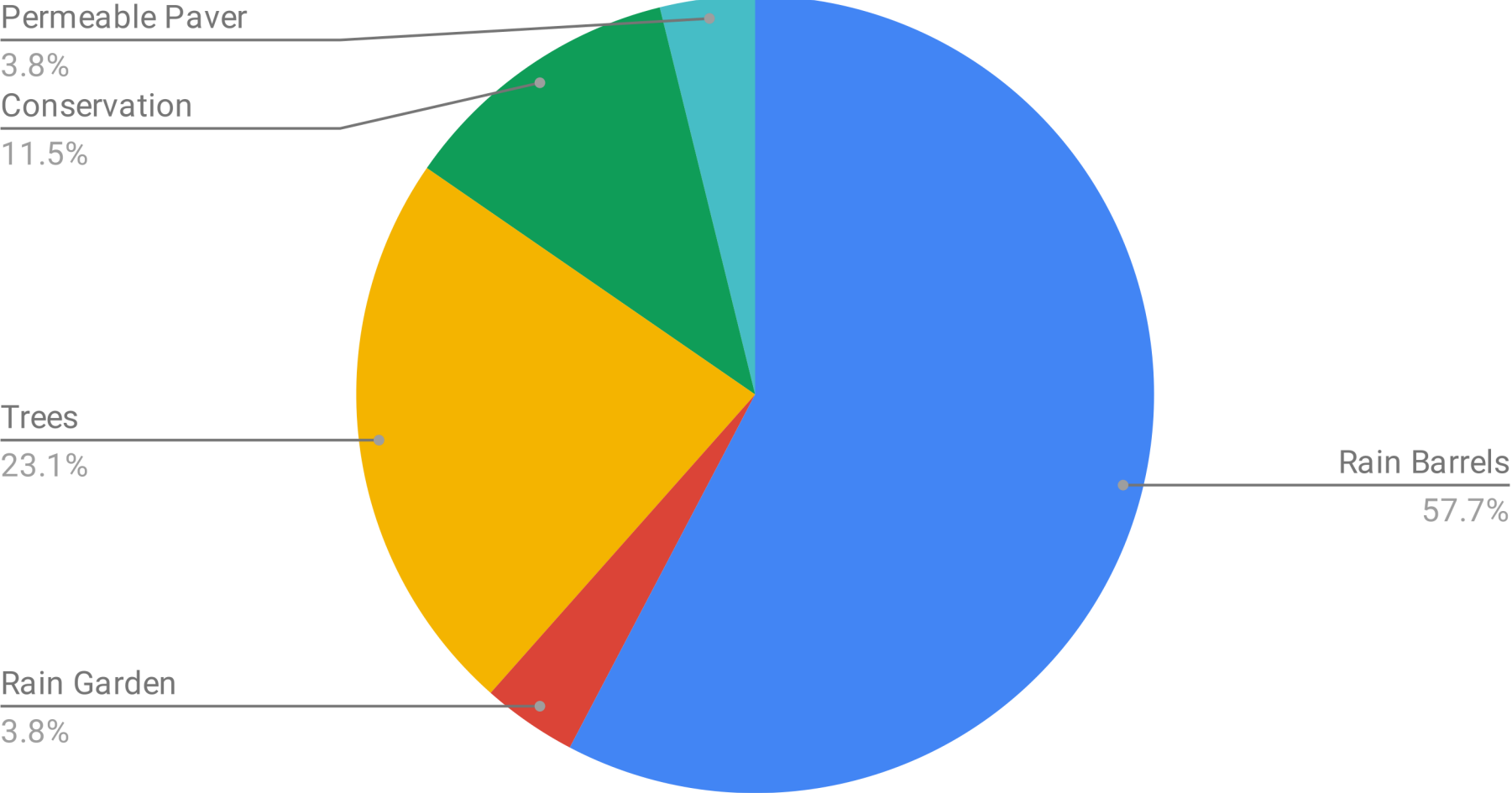
Project Applicants per Municipality



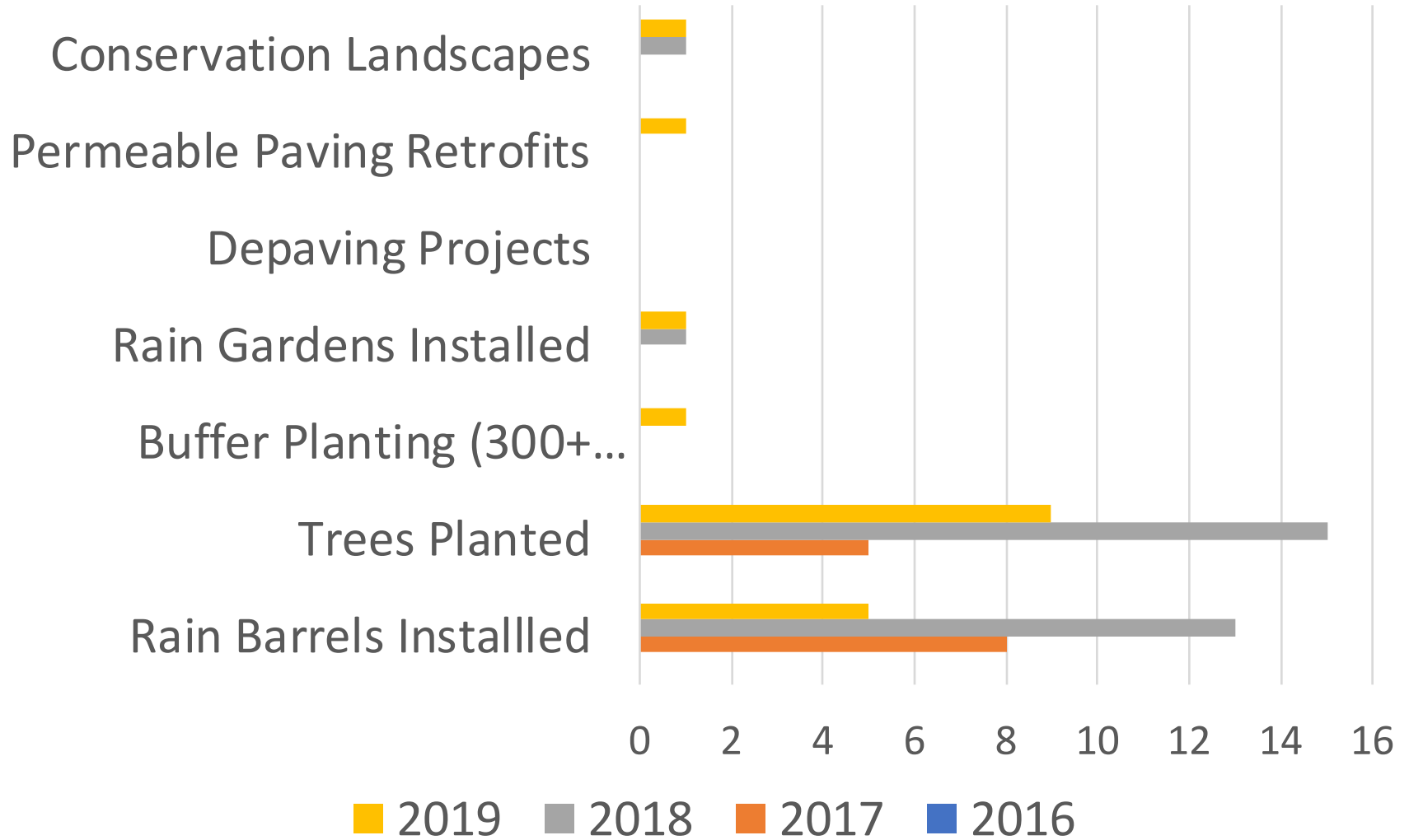
Implemented Projects per Municipality



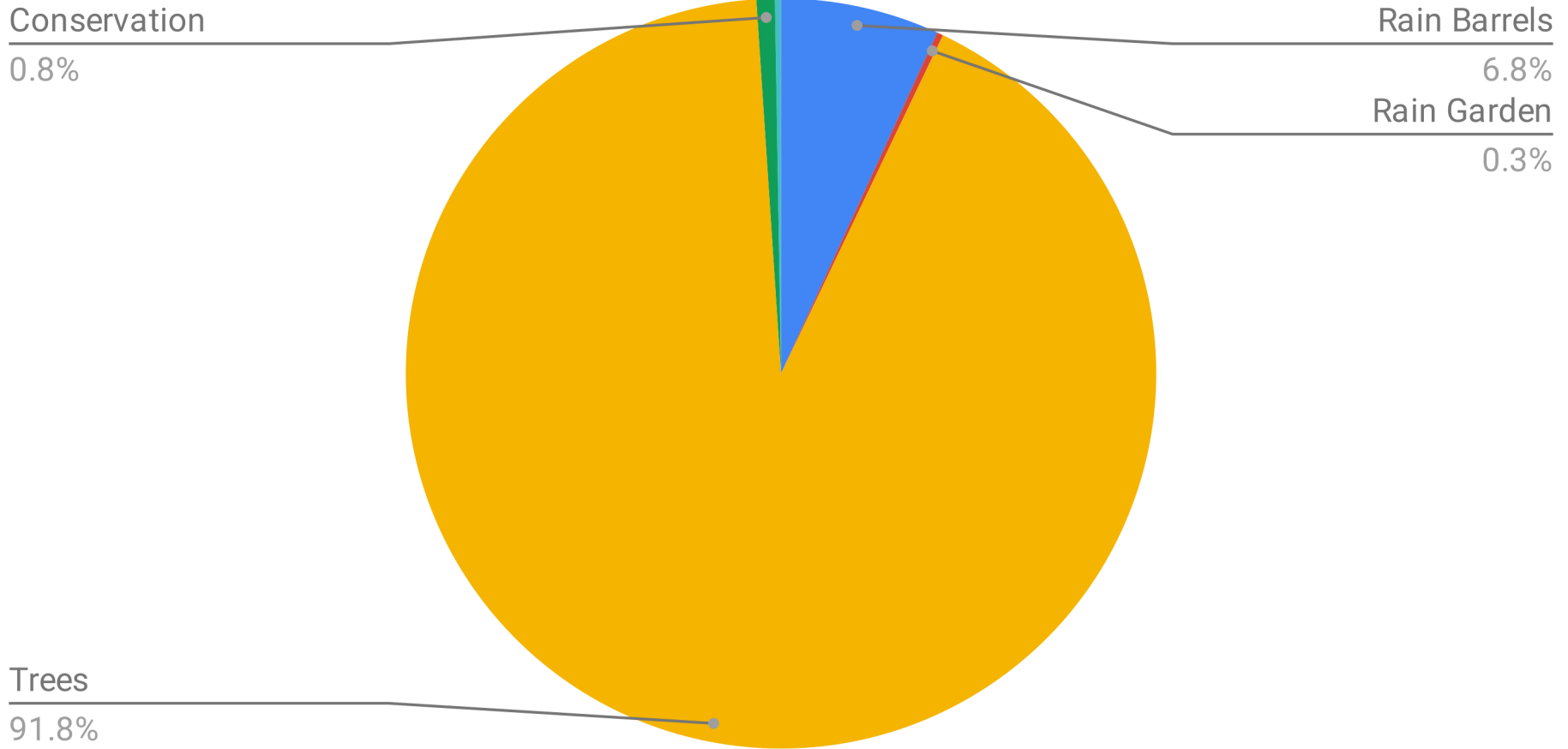
Popular Practices (count is by yes or no per Applicant)
