This is a public demonstration rain garden. It is fully vegetated with native plants to enhance wildlife habitat and provide a natural aesthetic. The drainage area from the adjacent roof is approximately 3,100 square feet. Two downspouts were diverted to the rain garden. Large river rocks were placed at the inlets and overflow area to prevent erosion during large rain events. This project assists the municipality with reaching its overall stormwater pollution reduction requirements and minimum control measures for public education and outreach (MCM 1) and pollution prevention/good housekeeping (MCM 6) by managing runoff from municipal-owned land and providing staff training.
